## Staff Reports

- Council resolved to approve Development Variance Permit #03-2022 to permit a relaxation of the minimum parcel size from 10,000 m<sup>2</sup> to 8,000 m<sup>2</sup> in an R-5 zone.
- Council resolved to adopt the Taylor/Peace River Regional District (Charlie Lake) Mutual Aid Agreement with a new five-year term ending in 2027.
- Council resolved to support the Lone Wolf Golf Club Update Project grant application.
