Committee of the Whole

Staff Reports

- The Committee requested that letters of thanks be provided to presenters that attended the Community Discussion on property crime.
- The Committee discussed 2023 proposed tax rate options and agreed to approval in principle of the following taxation rates which is a 4.5% even increase across all classes:
 - Residential: 3.7875
 - Utilities: 36.0768
 - Major Industry: 43.9967
 - Light Industry: 23.2743
 - Commercial: 5.7893
 - Recreational: 3.7392
 - Farm: 5.3009
- The Committee reviewed proposed 2023 fees and charges for water, sewer, and garbage, and requested that staff bring back a report to the next meeting which includes the cost of water production for the District.

- Council resolved to purchase and grant the following items for the 2023 Taylor Curling Club 2x2 Bonspiel being held on Saturday, March 4, 2023:
 - One junior golf package (valued at \$150)
 - 30 skating passes for junior curlers (valued at \$60)
 - Four 18-hole adult green fee passes (valued at \$240)
