**A BYLAW OF THE DISTRICT OF TAYLOR
TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF THE MUNICIPAL
TICKET INFORMATION SYSTEM
BYLAW NO. 468, 1993**

WHEREAS Section 934.1(1)(a) of the Municipal Act empowers the District to, by bylaw, designate those bylaws for which the municipal ticket information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement;

AND WHEREAS Section 934.1(1)(c) of the Municipal Act empowers the Council to, by bylaw, authorize the use of any word or expression on a municipal ticket information to designate an offence against a bylaw;

AND WHEREAS Section 934.1(10) of the Municipal Act empowers the Council to, by bylaw, set fine amounts in consultation with the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court:

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to authorize the use of the municipal ticket information for the enforcement of certain bylaws, to authorize the use of certain words or expressions to designate certain bylaw offences and to set certain fine amounts.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Taylor in open meeting assembled ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 468, 1993."
2. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A of this Bylaw, as amended from time to time, may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Section 934.1 of the Municipal Act.
3. The persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule A to this Bylaw are designated as bylaw enforcement officers pursuant to Section 934.1(1)(b) of the Municipal Act for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A opposite the respective job positions.
4. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules B1 through B7 to this Bylaw designate the offences committed under the bylaw section numbers appearing in Column 2 opposite the respective words or expressions.
5. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules B1 through B7 to this bylaw are the fines set pursuant to section 934.1(10) of the Municipal Act for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
6. This Bylaw shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
