BYLAW NO. 858, 2022**

**DISTRICT OF TAYLOR TRAFFIC AND PARKING AMENDMENT BYLAW**

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the District of Taylor in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

**TITLE**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "District of Taylor Traffic and Parking Amendment Bylaw No. 858, 2022".

**AMENDMENT**

2. That the sections of Traffic and Parking Bylaw No. 718, 2006 as identified below be amended by replacing the gross vehicle weight of 8,500 kilograms (18,700 pounds) with a gross vehicle weight of 12,500 kilograms (27,500 pounds):

**4. STOPPING OR PARKING OF VEHICLES**

**1. Parking Prohibitions**

Except when necessary to avoid conflict with traffic or to comply with the law or the directions of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Peace Officer, or traffic control device, no person shall:

- o) drive, stop or park a vehicle having a licensed gross vehicle weight of over 12,500 kilograms (27,500 pounds) on any street designated for residential traffic;

**5. STREET USAGE**

**3. Vehicle Weight Restrictions/Truck Routes**

- b) no person shall drive or operate a vehicle of over 12,500 kilograms (27,500 lbs) on paved residential roads unless so designated.

3. That the section of Traffic and Parking Bylaw No. 718, 2006 as identified below be amended to include the addition of the following subsection:

**4. General**

- i) No person shall obstruct a sidewalk or road.
