- The Committee requested that additional information be provided at a later date surrounding Advertising and Sponsorship Agreement details.

- Council resolved to grant 100% fee forgiveness of ball diamond rental fees for the 12<sup>th</sup> annual Arnie Isberg Memorial 1-Pitch Softball Tournament being held from June 23 – 25, 2023, with endorsement provided for operation of a beer gardens and the requirement to contact the Fire Chief to discuss emergency planning.
- Council resolved to provide letters to Northern BC Tourism in support of their grant applications to the Marketing Initiatives fund for the Northern BC Travel Journal Project, and the Northern Healthy Communities Program for the Northern BC Tourism Resiliency Program.
