Peace Island Park Rules

- ⇒ All campers must check in at our office, this includes group site users.
- ⇒ Quiet time begins at 11pm
- ⇒ All dogs must be on a leash. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. Pets are not to be left unattended.
- ⇒ ATVs are permitted only in designated areas, and must be trailered in and out of the park.
- ⇒ Fireworks are not permitted in the park.
- ⇒ Discharge of firearms is not permitted in the park.
- ⇒ Adherence to current provincial fire bans is required
- ⇒ Please report all bear sightings to the Conservation Officer at 1-877-952-7277

Check In and Check Out:

- ⇒ Check in times begin at 12pm
- ⇒ Check out is 11am
- ⇒ Quad site check in begins at 2pm
- ⇒ Quad site check out is 1pm
- ⇒ Quiet time begins at 11pm

For adjusted check in and check out times please speak with Peace Island Park staff

Park and Campfire Safety

- ⇒ All vehicles must fit within the confines of your camp site. Do not block or park on roads.
- ⇒ All camping units must be placed no less than 15 feet apart in all areas, including group camping areas.
- ⇒ Campfires must be attended at all times.
- ⇒ Have a minimum of 8L of water available for extinguishing.
- ⇒ Do not burn garbage, please use garbage bins provided.
- ⇒ Campfires may not exceed 0.5 x 0.5 x 0.5 metres in size.
- ⇒ Do not light or continue to burn campfires in windy conditions.
- ⇒ Adherence to the current Provincial fire bans are required.
