The Taylor Public Library is directed by a five-member library board which consists of four members from the community and one member from Council.

We are guided by legislation created by the BC Provincial Library Branch called the "Library Act" and a Provincial Strategic Plan for Libraries.

Our Board is the decision maker for the library creating its own policies and procedures for day-to-day operations of the library. Funding comes from Provincial grants and a budget allowance from the District of Taylor.

Are you interested? We are seeking applicants to fill two 24-month terms from December 1, 2023, to November 30, 2025, and meetings are typically held once per month at the discretion of the Board.

Appointments to the Board are approved by District Council (as directed in the Library Act).
