SUBJECT: PLANNED WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION

Dear Resident/Occupant,

To repair a water service leak on 102 Street, the District of Taylor will need to temporarily shut off the water main in the area to address the situation.

- **Date of Shutdown:** March 3, 2026
- **Time of Shutdown:** 12:30 p.m. (Approx.)
- **Location/Affected Area:** Pine Avenue West to 106 Avenue between 101 Street and 102 Street



Pre-shutdown Preparation:

- **Store Water:** Please store enough water for drinking, cooking, and sanitation (e.g., filling bathtubs to flush toilets) before the scheduled time.
- **Protect Appliances:** Turn off water-intensive appliances like dishwashers and washing machines.
- **Hot Water Tank:** If you have a private hot water tank, we recommend turning off its electrical switch to prevent damage.

After Service Restored:

Along with the repairs, air can sometimes enter the system. Once the water is turned back on, if you experience any air or discoloration, please run your tap for 5 – 10 minutes. The water should clear up and return to normal. If the issue continues, please call the District Office at 250-789-3392.
